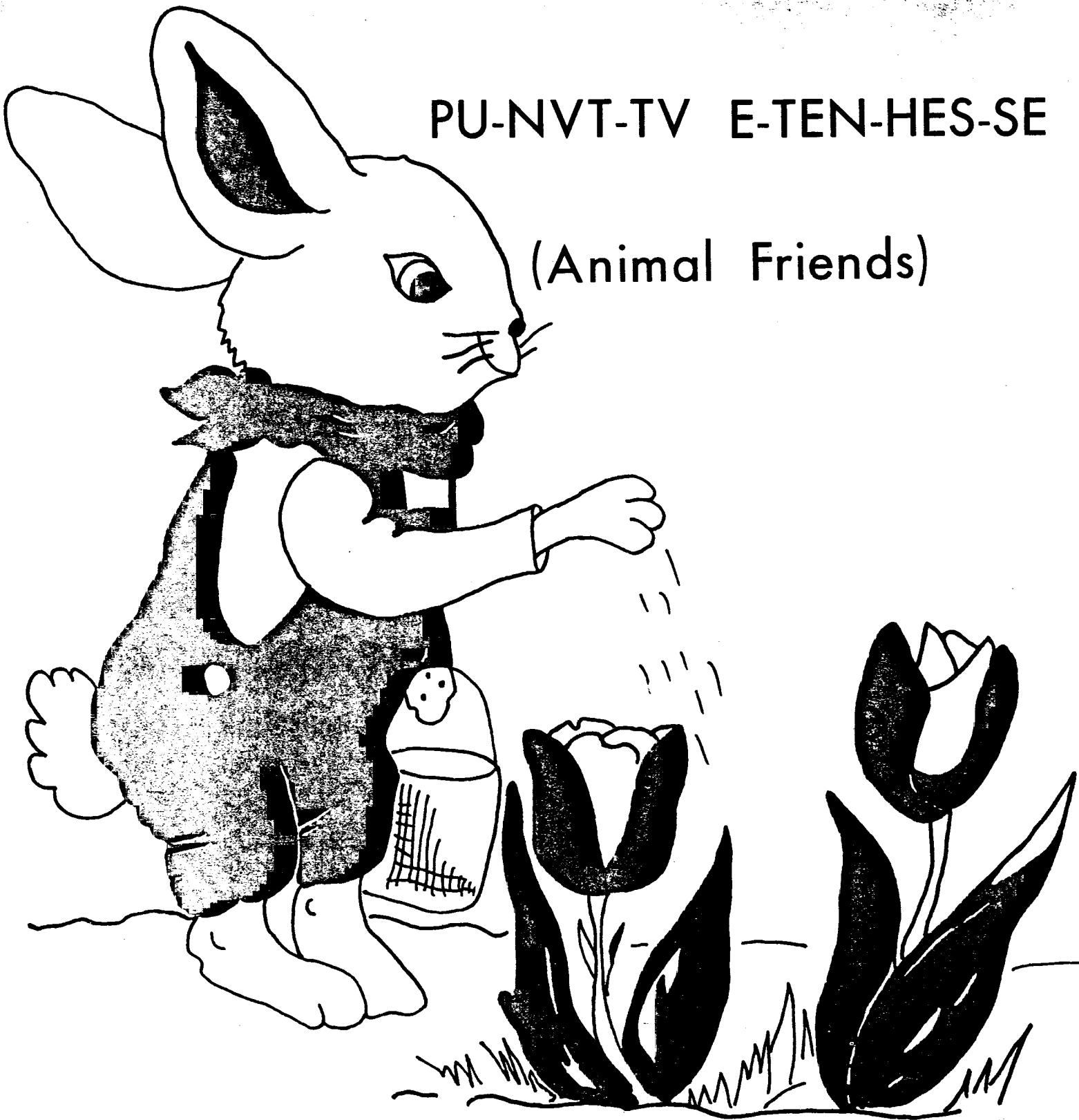

Revised in Summer 1978.

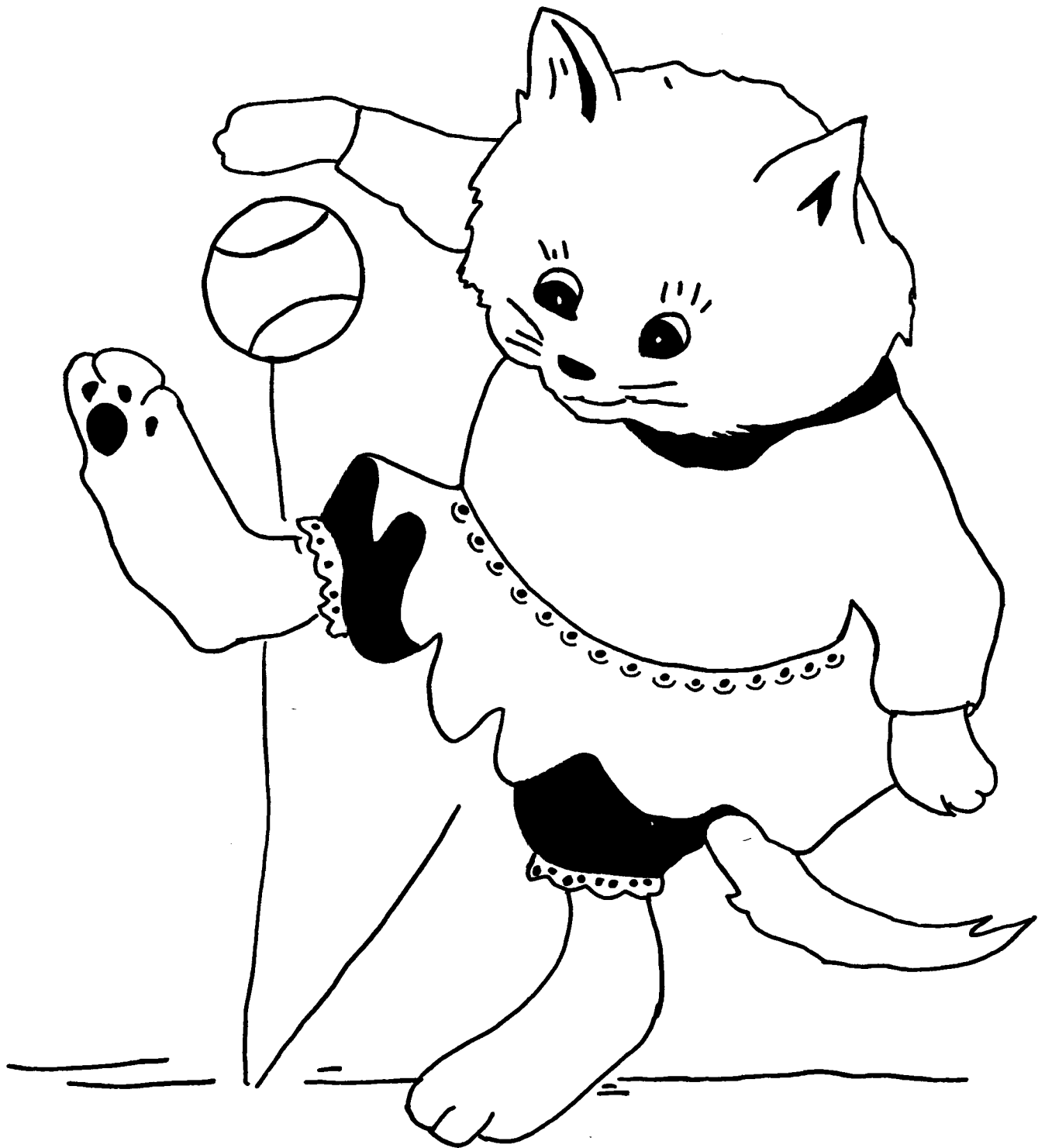
Animal Friends was developed to help boys and girls involved in the Seminole Bilingual Education Program to begin simple reading in the Maskoke (Muskokee) language.

The reading book was written and illustrated by Edmond A. Harjo, Community Language and Culture Coordinator.

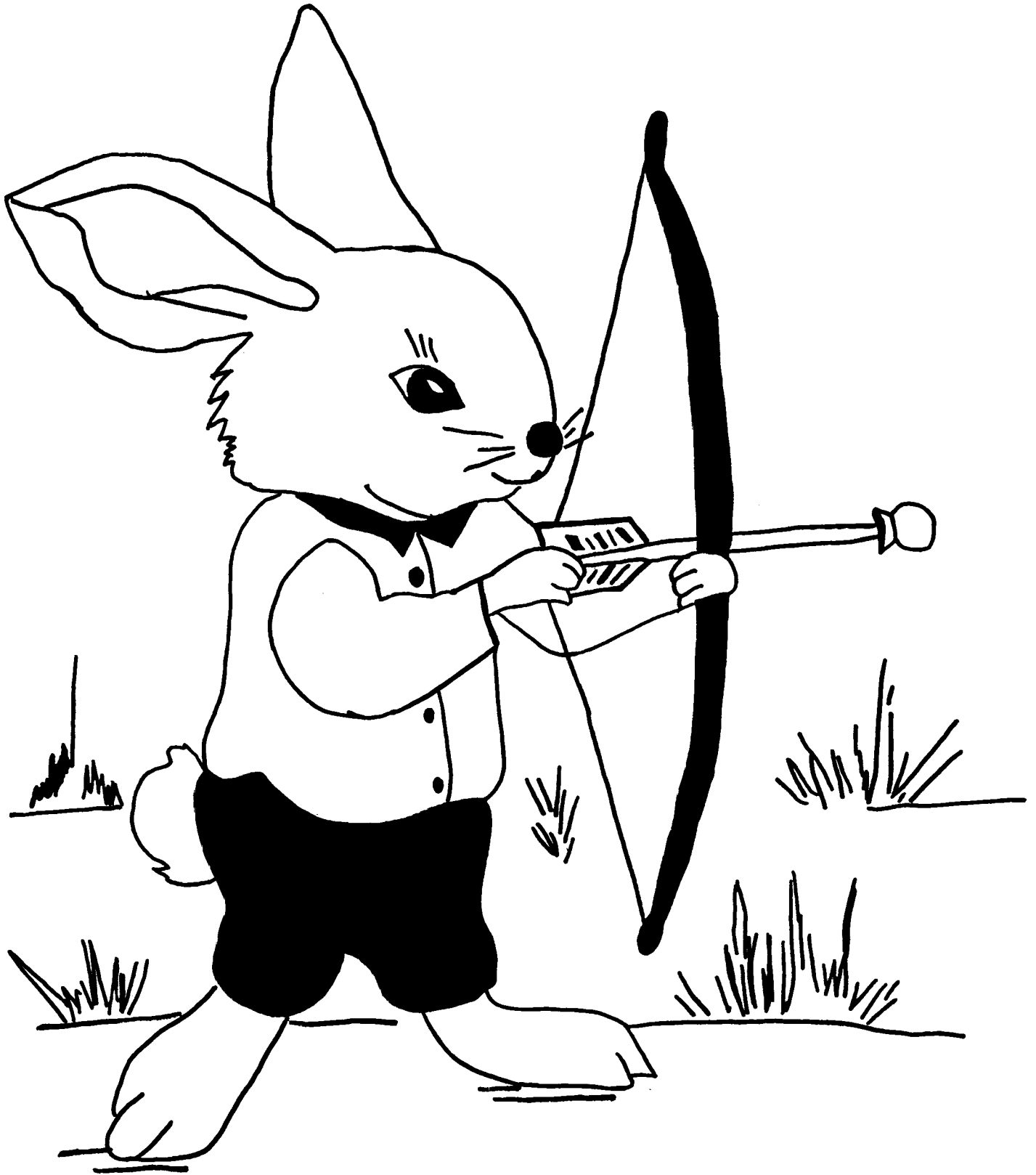
